

- All permitted waste must be placed at the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled pick-up day.
- All garbage that is not a large item must be placed at the roadside in large garbage bags.
   NO LOOSE SMALL WHITE SHOPPING BAGS.
   The large garbage bags may be put at the roadside in garbage cans if desired.
- Each garbage bag must be tagged with ONE Township of Beckwith garbage tag.
- Place tags where they are clearly visible.
- Do not place tags on garbage cans or reusable containers.
- Each garbage bag cannot weigh more than 20 kg.
- Garbage should not be put out at the roadside the evening before unless it is put in a container that prohibits animals from getting into the garbage.
- Garbage collection takes place on Monday for all residents living west of Hwy. 15, and Tuesday for all residents living east of Hwy. 15. There are two exceptions: garbage will not be picked up on Christmas Day or New Year's Day.
- Tv's, electronics, microwaves etc, should be brought to an Electronics Depot.
- A yearly allotment of 80 garbage tags is available at the first of January at the Beckwith Township Municipal Office for the calendar year. Additional tags may be purchased at a price of \$2 per tag.
- Anyone, other than the owner of the property, who plans on picking up tags, MUST HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE OWNER(S).



Recyclables will only be collected if they are placed in, or next to, a blue box!

Recycling will now be picked up at the same time as waste, so it is essential that both (recycling and waste) be at the curb no later than 7 a.m.

### SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING PROGRAM – ALL TOGETHER NOW

- Metal Aluminum and steel food and beverage bottles and containers, foil and plates, EMPTY aerosol cans
- Paper and Cardboard Paper cups, fine print, paper, flyers, newspaper, books, egg cartons, magazines, envelopes, boxboard, brochures, and polycoat containers (i.e. gable top, Tetra Pak, frozen juice containers, milk and juice cartons)
- Glass Clear and coloured food and beverage bottles, jars and containers
- ✓ Plastic (#1 7) Bottles, jugs, tubs, lids and rigid packaging and containers from food, beverage and household products (i.e. shampoo, ice cream, yogurt, clear shells, bags with the symbol on it).

# PLEASE RINSE CONTAINERS REMOVE CAPS – RECYCLE SEPARATELY NO NEED TO REMOVE LABELS

#### **ONE TRUCK - ONE STOP**

On the new split truck the larger side of the truck is for waste to be disposed of at transfer or landfill site. The smaller side of the truck is for co-mingled recycle materials to be dropped at transfer site or MRF.

★ <u>Please note:</u> There is **NO** blue box or garbage collection on Christmas Day (December 25<sup>th</sup>) or New Year's Day (January 1<sup>s)</sup> if they fall on a Monday or Tuesday collection day.

- Any household garbage that does not fit in a large garbage bag or exceeds 20 kg is considered a LARGE ITEM.
- Examples of large items include: bundles of waste, couches, refrigerators (Freon must be removed), televisions, mattresses, stoves, etc. Construction material will not be picked up.
- Bundles of waste must be securely tied and must not exceed 1.5 m x 60 cm x 60 cm in dimension and 20 kg in weight.
- Each large item set out for pick-up MUST have 3 stickers affixed to it.
- Rolls of carpet must be securely bundled and must not exceed 1.5 m in length and 20 kg in weight.
- White-metal appliances, such as clothes washers and dryers, refrigerators, stoves, and hot water tanks, are to be placed at the roadside on large item pick-up days only. Please note that they may not be picked up until the following day.
- Large item pick-up will take place on the first regular garbage collection day of the month as listed below:

<u>Uncollectible Waste:</u> Items that will not be picked up include:

- Articles which are not bundled
- Automobiles, Ski-doo's etc., or parts thereof
- Articles larger than 20 kg or 1.5 m long
- Construction or manufacturing waste
- Patio doors or picture window frames with glass still in them
- Stones, earth, stumps, etc.
- Dry wall
- Yard waste (Take to dump yourself)
- Household hazardous waste
- Water pressure tanks or fire extinguishers
- Iron, steel or other scrap metals
- Tires
- Carcasses of any animal
- Liquid waste
- Medical waste
- Night soil and animal waste
- Any explosive or highly combustible material
- Any material that is stuck to the inside of the garbage can
- Items which are not appropriately tagged with Township of Beckwith garbage tags

Some uncollectible waste can be taken to Beckwith Transfer Station located at 9271 Cavanagh Road, phone 613-257-1195 or Glenview Iron and Metal located at 3954 Highway 43, phone #613-283-5230. This would be the responsibility of the homeowner. There will be a fee charged for all devices which are known to contain refrigerant that are not DRAINED & TAGGED BY A LICENSED TECHNICIAN

This includes: Vehicles, Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners and Dehumidifiers.
