Acceptable Items



DUAL STREAM RECYCLING, MEANS YOUR RECYCLABLES MUST BE SEPERATED INTO "CONTAINERS" AND "FIBRE & PAPER"

RECYCLE RIGHT, TOWNSHIP OF HORTON

Include these items (rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue) in their apppropriate dual stream recycle bin – **no bagging of recyclables allowed**

CONTAINER RECYCLING BIN place items loosly in blue box, and do not bag recyclables

PLASTICS

- WHAT Plastics labeled #1, 2, 3, 5, 6 & 7 including plastic bottles, lids, clamshells, plastic food containers, jugs and trays.
- HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.





GLASS

- WHAT HOW
- Glass bottles and jars. Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.





Boxed containers for beverages and soups. Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.

METAL

- WHAT Tin food cans, lids and beverage containers, aluminum cans and empty paint cans (no plastic paint cans or cans with plastic bottoms).
- HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.

FIBRE & PAPER RECYCLING BIN place items loosly in blue box, do not bag recyclables

PAPER

- WHAT Newspaper, magazines, printer and writing paper, junk mail and shredded paper.
- HOW Shredded paper in a clear plastic bag. This is the only item that should be bagged.



CARDBOARD

WHAT Corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, box board, paper board and cartons. No larger than $4' \times 4' \times 1'$.

How to place your waste & recycling for collection

Your recyclables - must be seperated and placed in two separate blue bins.

If your recyclables are not arranged properly, your blue bins will not be collected.

Your waste - must be placed in standard size 77 L or less bags, weigh no more than 50 Lbs. There is a limit of two untagged bags.

Additional bags require tags. Tags are available at the Municipal Office for \$2.00 each. Alternatively, additional waste bags can be taken to the landfill at a \$2.00 per bag rate.

Setting your materials at the curb - set all materials at the curb by 7 am on your collection day.

In winter - clear snow away from the area around your material and do not place bins or bags behind or on top of snowbanks.

Unacceptable Items These items require alternative handling.


