PLASTICS

Symbol 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 (usually found on the bottom of container) such as:



- ✓ Berry containers
- ✓ Bulk lettuce containers
- ✓ Condiment bottles
- ✓ Cracker and cookie trays
- ✓ Large yogurt tubs
- ✓ Laundry jugs
- ✓ Margarine tubs & lids
- ✓ Plastic coffee containers
- ✓ Plastic flower pots
- ✓ Plastic lids (with a symbol) larger than the size of your palm
- ✓ Plastic milk jugs
- ✓ Plastic pails
- ✓ Plastic take out drink cups
- ✓ Salad dressing bottles
- ✓ Shampoo/Conditioner bottles
- ✓ Tupperware containers
- ✓ Vitamin/pill bottles
- ✓ Water and juice bottles (if not returning for refund)

PLASTICS MUST HAVE A SYMBOL TO BE RECYCLED
NO PLASTIC BAGS OR WRAP, EVEN IF NUMBERED

PAPER

- ✓ Books (hard covers must be removed)
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Greeting cards (plain)
- ✓ Loose paper
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Newspapers and flyers
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Shredded paper in transparent bags



CARDBOARD

- ✓ Cereal boxes
- ✓ Cracker boxes
- ✓ Corrugated boxes
- ✓ Drink trays
- ✓ Egg cartons
- ✓ Other food boxes
- ✓ Paper towel & toilet paper rolls
- ✓ Shoe boxes



METAL

- ✓ Aluminum cooking pans, plates & tin foil
- ✓ Beverage cans (if not returning for refund)
- ✓ Food cans (vegetable, fruits, soup, meats...)
- ✓ Juice cans
- ✓ Pet food cans



**Remove labels if you can. Sharp-edged lids should be left attached or secured inside the can.*

ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEANED AND DRIED BEFORE PLACING IN BIN.

NOT ACCEPTED

- ✗ No glass of any kind
- ✗ Milk & juice cartons/tetra packs
- ✗ Binders
- ✗ Film plastics (ex: wrap around paper towel)
- ✗ Foam egg cartons, trays & take out containers (even if numbered)
- ✗ Paper towel & tissues
- ✗ Pellet bags and feed bags
- ✗ Plastic shopping/bread bags
- ✗ Plastics without a number
- ✗ Straws
- ✗ No coat hangers (plastic or wire)
- ✗ No disposable coffee cups
- ✗ No garbage
- ✗ No lottery tickets
- ✗ No store receipts
- ✗ No styrofoam
- ✗ No soiled or wet items of any kind
