Accepted materials

Here's a summary of some of the materials you can recycle!



Boxboard and cardboard: Corrugated cardboard, cereal, pasta, and shoe boxes.



Papers: Envelopes, newsprint paper, mail inserts and flyers.



Metal: Food and beverage cans, empty aerosol containers and paint cans, aluminum foil.



Plastic: Food and beverage containers, bottles, plastic egg cartons, tubs and lids, gable top containers.



Glass: Jars and bottles.



As of January 1, 2025, Callander's recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in Ontario.

Recycling tips:

- ☒ Sort recyclable materials from garbage and organics.
- ☒ Flatten corrugated cardboard and boxboard and tie in bundles measuring no larger than 75 cm x 75 cm x 20 cm (30" x 30" x 8"). Place next to bin.
- ☒ Empty and give containers a quick rinse.
- ☒ Keep materials loose in your bin.
