#### **Accepted materials**

Here's a quick summary of some of the materials that you can recycle!

#### **Grey bin**



Cardboard: Cereal boxes, corrugated cardboard, paper towel rolls.

**Papers:** Envelopes, newsprint paper.







#### **Blue bin**



Metal: Food and beverage cans, aerosol containers, aluminum foil, aluminum containers, empty paint cans.

**Plastic:** Containers and lids, bottles, cans, gable top milk and juice cartons, styrofoam, flower pots & trays.

Glass: Jars, bottles.



Niagara Region's recycling program is now managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in Ontario.

There is no change to the materials you currently recycle or your recycling schedule.

### **Recycling tips:**

- Sort recyclable materials from garbage and organics.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard.
- Empty and give containers a quick rinse.
- Keep materials loose.
- Recycling bins should not exceed the size of 20 inches in height x 17.25 inches in width

## Recycling is collected weekly

#### Blue bin



- Place containers loosely inside the blue bin.
- ✓ Empty and rinse containers.

#### **Grey bin**



Cardboard should be flattened and placed tightly in the grey bin, in a cardboard box or tied in bundled no larger than 3ft x 3ft x 3ft.

#### Be recycle ready

- Keep recycling bins separated from garbage and organics.
- ✓ Bins should weigh no more than 50 lbs.
- If your bins are full, use another container for your recycling that is labeled and has handles.
- Do not place your bins on top of, in front of, or behind snowbanks.

- ✓ Sign up for collection reminders.

#### **HOLIDAY COLLECTION**

There will be no collection on Christmas Day or New Years Day in 2025.

Following these holidays, collection will occur one day later than regularly scheduled for those weeks only.
