About Nova Scotia's recycling program

Nova Scotia is transitioning to an extended producer responsibility (EPR) system for packaging and paper products. This system shifts the financial and operational responsibility for recycling from Regional Service Commissions, entities, and First Nations to the producers who supply the products.

Timeline for onboarding recycling services to schools

March 1, 2025

Registration opens for free recycling services with Circular Materials.

December 1, 2025

Launch of EPR recycling services for registered schools.

May 30, 2025

Deadline for schools to register in order to receive service by December 1, 2025.
