

What can you recycle?

Recycle right! Here is a summary of some of the materials that you can recycle.



Paper/cardboard

Printer paper, muffin wrappers, toilet paper rolls.



Metal

Tin cans, aluminum foil, pie plates.



Plastic

Yogurt containers, sandwich bags, plastic jugs.



Glass

Clear and coloured food containers and jars.

Lids and caps off.



Foam packaging, flexible plastics and aerosol containers are not accepted in your curbside recycling. These materials can be recycled at a depot near you: circularmaterials.ca/NSdepots
