Accepted in your building's recycling bins

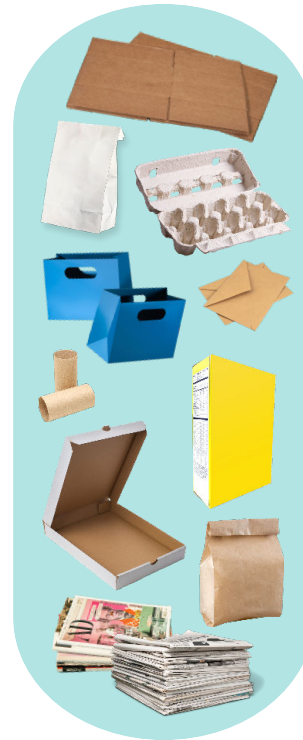
Place materials empty, dry and loose into a clear blue bag and place bag in the designated bin. Ensure cardboard is flattened and bundled.

Containers



- Laundry detergent jugs
- Shampoo bottles
- Toothpaste tubes
- Sandwich bags
- Plastic shopping bags
- Ice cream containers
- Coffee cups
- Soup and sauce cartons
- Pie plates
- Food cans
- Glass jars and bottles

Fibre



- Flattened cardboard
- Toilet paper and paper towel rolls
- Egg cartons
- Pizza and cereal boxes
- Newspaper and magazines
- Prescription bags
- Greeting cards and envelopes
- Muffin bags
- Paper gift bags

Foam packaging, flexible plastics and aerosol containers are not accepted in your curbside recycling. Please bring them to a participating drop-off location near you: circularmaterials.ca/NSdepots.
